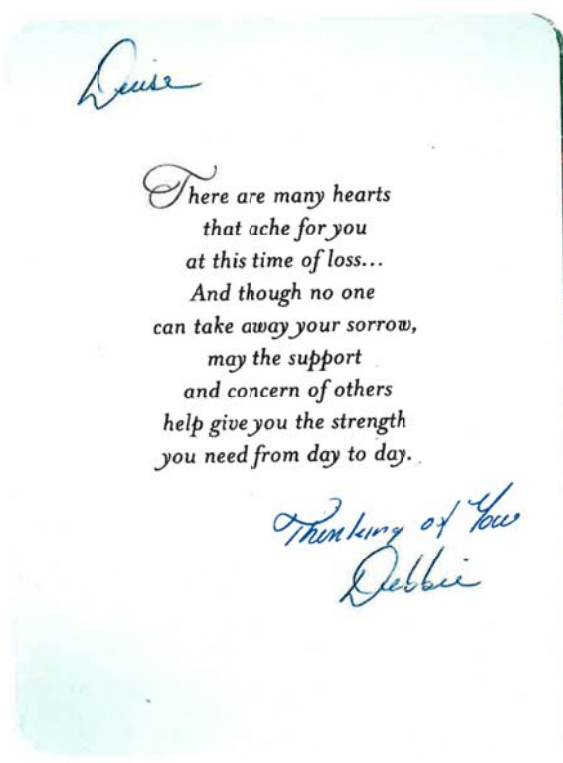
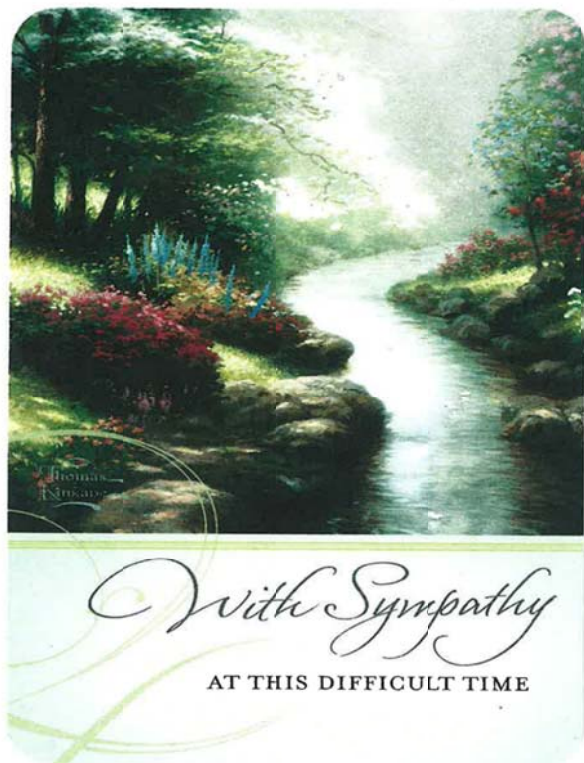
I just read your message. I am sure Frogmore will be in a good place. Our horses are such an important part in serving our children. I am sure. Frogmore helped many of them.
